

Auction Compliance Disclosures

The following information is being posted voluntarily by Southern Companies in conjunction with the Energy Auction and in an effort to keep participants informed about the implementation and operation of the Energy Auction. Participants should continue to direct requests for more information, as well as questions, comments or complaints, to the Auction Administrator or the Independent Auction Monitor utilizing the links provided on the previous page.

- On November 29, 2011, Southern became aware of several additional occurrences of the programming issue identified on November 10, 2011. This issue caused the following MW amounts to be excluded from the DAE Auction available capacity offerings: 150 MW on October 18; 303 MW on October 19; 160 MW on November 8; 111 MW on November 17 and 200 MW on November 25. Southern identified the root cause of the issue and implemented a solution effective November 30, 2011. Posted: 12/05/2011
- On November 29, 2011, a repeat of the programming issue identified on September 6, 2011 caused 298 MW to be excluded from the DAE Auction available capacity offering for November 17, 2011. Southern has now identified the root cause of the issue and has engaged the third party software vendor in an effort to implement a permanent solution. Posted: 12/05/2011.
- On November 10, 2011, Southern became aware of a transient technical issue that caused the November 4, 2011, DAE available capacity offering to be decremented by 73MW. Posted: 11/15/2011
